Stewart Craven was a senior mathematics teacher at Marc Garneau Collegiate Institute. For eight years he was the Coordinator for Mathematics for the Toronto District School Board where he was responsible for professional development for over 8000 teachers of mathematics. Since retiring from TDSB he delivers science programs at the Ontario Science Centre to students from Kindergarten to Grade 12, teaches three courses at York University, and consults for organizations such as Learning Through The Arts and Television Ontario.

In 1992 he was awarded the Prime Minster's Award for Excellence in Teaching Mathematics and Science.
