On behalf of the parents and children of Toronto-Danforth, I am appealing for your attention to a serious safety issue of grave concern to our school communities.

Earl Haig Public School is located in a very busy area with a large volume of vehicle and pedestrian traffic throughout the day. I have received many letters and telephone calls from worried parents concerned about the unsafe conditions and potential for serious incidents as their children travel to and from school. In addition, I understand that there have recently been two collisions involving Earl Haig students.

Residents of my ward view this as a dangerous crossing, warranting the placement of a crossing guard, and I agree. I fully support the community's request for the addition of a crossing guard at the corner of Coxwell Avenue and Hanson Street and request a traffic survey to determine feasibility.

Your support of this safety initiative would be greatly appreciated. I thank you in advance for your consideration in this matter and look forward to your response.
